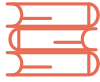


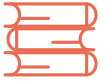
PRESCHOOL HOME ESSENTIALS

This list isn't mandatory, but we thought it would be fun to include a list of things you can keep at home to help your child learn even when they're not at school.



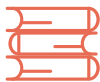
It doesn't have to be expensive or fancy. Even the basics can help your child develop a lifelong love of learning! Here are a few things to get started:



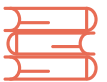
- o A small table or desk

- o 2-4 fat pencils

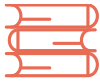


This is all you need to get started, but there are other things that can make the space more enjoyable:
